#### Policy Spirit and Intent

Chalo School was established primarily to serve the students of Fort Nelson First Nation as a priority. However, Chalo School maintains an open registration approach and welcomes students who live in neighbouring communities

#### Admission of Students / Student Registration

1. Students enrolling in Chalo School for the first time will submit an application that will be subject to review and approval by the principal.
  - 1.1 Students transferring to Chalo School because of a change in their place of residence will be considered anytime during the year.
  - 1.2 Whenever possible, students transferring to Chalo School will be enrolled prior to the September 30<sup>th</sup> nominal roll deadline date.
  - 1.3 Students who are in grades 8-12 and who register after September 30<sup>th</sup>, may be required to wait until second semester to begin classes.
  - 1.4 Students returning to Chalo School will not be required to re-apply every year but will be required to update registration information.
  
2. Limits to enrolment. (See Appendix: Class size guidelines.)
  - 2.1 Chalo School reserves the right to refuse admission to any student based on funding constraints, enrolment limitations, or other relevant and legally acceptable considerations.
  - 2.2 If class size limitations or class composition factors require the school to limit enrolment, priority will be given to FNFN students residing on reserve and then to FNFN members living off reserve.
  - 2.3 Chalo School may decline to enrol students based on class composition factors.
  - 2.4 Chalo School may decline to enrol a student if the principal, in consultation with staff, believes that the student’s needs cannot be adequately met at Chalo School.
