STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY STATEMENT - 5080

While the Community Education Authority recognizes that dress is a legitimate avenue of individual expression, acceptable student dress will be subject to the following guidelines:

Guidelines:

1. Where safety is placed at risk, principals may restrict the wearing of clothing, adornments, and hairstyles.
2. Principals must ensure that wear appropriate safety clothing and equipment when required.
3. Principals may require students to return home and change their appearance. When this occurs the student may re-attend school without penalty.

At Chalo we respect individual styles while we consider the feelings of others. It is expected that students dress in a manner conducive to positive teaching and learning environment, similar to what would be acceptable at a work setting.
