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**Policy Spirit and Intent**

The Fort Nelson First Nation Community Education believes that a strong educational program is one of the essential components required to develop as strong, proud, healthy and self-reliant community members.

This incentive was put in place to recognize our Fort Nelson First Nation Band Members who have completed an academic semester at the secondary level (grades 8-12.) The student report card incentive will be paid out in accordance with the secondary school’s reporting periods and will be based on attendance, student effort/achievement, and academic excellence results reported on the report cards. There will be no retroactive payments made.

The student report card incentive is intended for Fort Nelson First Nation band members. This mean Fort Nelson First Nation members that have completed the membership probation period, and are entitled to all Fort Nelson First Nation funded programs, will be the only students who receive payment.

The Education Coordinator will receive report cards for students attending Chalo or FNSS directly, provided they have a signed Aboriginal Consent Form. For those students without a completed form on file at the school, their parents/guardians will be responsible for submitting their student’s report cards directly to the Education Coordinator to receive the incentive.

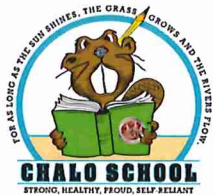
For all Fort Nelson First Nation band members students residing outside of the Fort Nelson area, parents/guardians may submit their student’s report cards directly to the Education Coordinator to receive the incentive.

**Student Report Card Incentives will be calculated using the rates below.**

Student Effort/Achievement

Students will receive a percentage of the incentive according to their course load.

“1” as a final mark in any subject.	\$0
25% course load pass rate.	\$0
50% course load pass rate.	\$40.00
75% course load pass rate.	\$60.00
100% course load pass rate.	\$80.00



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### Attendance Bonus

An absence is considered a full day away from school. Four lates in one day will be considered equal to one absence. Due to a pandemic a student shall receive the attendance bonus if he or she is passing courses.

0-5 absences during the reporting period.	\$50.00
5+ absences during the reporting period.	\$0

### Academic Excellence Bonus

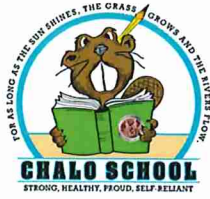
Students who achieve a total of six points or better will receive a bonus of \$35.00. Points are allocated based on the following system.

Letter Grade A	3 points
Letter Grade B	2 points
Letter Grade C+	1 point
Letter Grade C or less	0 points

For students who receive percentages as a final grade, points will be allocated as follows:

Grade of 86-100%	3 points
Grade of 73-85 %	2 points
Grade of 67-72%	1 point
Grade of 66% or less	0 points

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
